FIRST ITINERARY For KENYA

Day 1 - meet at airport at to check in for your connection flights

Day 2 - Arrival

On arrival at JKIA In Nairobi, you'll be met by our representative to transfer You to your hotel in Nairobi for overnight stay.

Day 3 - Nairobi to Maasai Mara.

Depart Nairobi early in the morning and journey through the Great Rift Valley towards Maasai Mara National Reserve. Upon arrival, check into your lodge and have lunch. In the afternoon, head out for an exciting game drive to catch the first glimpses of the remarkable wildlife – including the Big Five – that Maasai Mara is famed for. Return to your lodge for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 4 - Full Day in Maasai Mara.

Spend a full day exploring the vast plains of Maasai Mara. Morning and afternoon game drives will offer ample opportunities to witness the incredible wildlife, including lions, elephants, cheetahs, and possibly the breath-taking spectacle of the Great Migration (depending on the season). Enjoy a picnic lunch in the bush before continuing your safari adventure. Return to your lodge for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 5 - maasai mara to Mombasa.

Leave the maasai mara after breakfast to Nairobi where you will take a train to the coastal region of Mombasa at 3.00pm

Day 6 - Mombasa marine park.

go to the Mombasa marine park where you will take a boat to the ocean to view the fish and swim with the fish

Day 7 - Fort Jesus/Old town/hallar park.

visit fort Jesus museum for an insightful tour of the history of Mombasa then go to Mombasa old town. Later visit the hallar park

Day 8 - Mombasa/Nairobi

Travel back to Nairobi by train at 8:00 am. Get to hotel to relax

Day 9 - sheldrick elephant orphanage/ giraffe center

Full day excursion to the Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage, which is one of Africa's oldest wildlife charities. And a leading conservation organization where you will interact up close with elephants being rehabilitated and also adopt them. You will then proceed to the giraffe center where you will be able to play and feed the giraffes

Day 10 - Dirt bike riding and activities.

Day 11 - departure

SECOND ITINERARY For KENYA

Day 1 - On Arrival at JKIA In Nairobi, you'll be met by our representative to transfer You to your hotel in Nairobi for overnight stay.

Day 2 - sheldrick elephant orphanage/National Museum and snake park

Full day excursion to the Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage, which is one of Africa's oldest wildlife charities. And a leading conservation organization where you will interact up close with elephants being rehabilitated and can also adopt them. Then proceed to the National Museum/snake park

Excursion to the Nairobi National Museum, where it aims to interpret Kenya's rich heritage and offers a one stop for visitors to sample the country's rich heritage both for education and leisure. Then after, visit the Snake Park right next to the museum

Day 3 - Maasai Ostrich Farm

Visit the maasai ostrich farm which is East Africa's largest ostrich farm with over 1000 ostriches. Visitors will enjoy guided tours to observe ostriches at various stages of growth and experience ostrich rides under the supervision of trained instructors

Day 4 - Nairobi to Maasai Mara

Depart Nairobi early in the morning and journey through the Great Rift Valley towards Maasai Mara National Reserve. Upon arrival, check into your lodge and have lunch. In the afternoon, head out for an exciting game drive to catch the first glimpses of the remarkable wildlife – including the Big Five – that Maasai Mara is famed for. Return to your lodge for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 5 - Full Day in Maasai Mara

Spend a full day exploring the vast plains of Maasai Mara. Morning and afternoon game drives will offer ample opportunities to witness the incredible wildlife, including lions, elephants,

cheetahs, and possibly the breath-taking spectacle of the Great Migration (depending on the season). Enjoy a picnic lunch in the bush before continuing your safari adventure. Return to your lodge for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 6 - maasai mara to Nairobi

Go for your final safari in the Masai Mara in the morning, then make your departure back to Nairobi City to your hotel for dinner and overnight stay

Day 7 - Kazuri beads factory/ giraffe center

Excursion at the Kazuri Beads and Pottery factory. Here you will not only get to admire some of the most beautiful locally produced bead jewelry and pottery, but you'll also visit the workshop and learn about the history of the factory, and you will be able to make some jewelry and pottery by yourself. You will then proceed to the giraffe center where you will be able to play and feed the giraffes.

Day 8 - Gatura greens tea farm

Excursion to the nearby town of Thika to the Gatura Greens Purple Tea Farm, which is. The home of the fast purple tea farm in Kenya for an authentic tour and a taste of over 10 different types of teas made direct from their cottage factory.

Day 9 - departure

11 Days / 9 Nights

ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Day 1 – International Departure

International departure from Bosnia and Herzegovina to Nairobi, Kenya.

Day 2 – Arrival in Nairobi

Arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA). Meet and assist by our representative, followed by a private transfer to the hotel. Depending on arrival time, a short orientation drive may be arranged. Overnight in Nairobi.

Day 3 – Nairobi to Maasai Mara

After breakfast, depart Nairobi by road via the scenic Great Rift Valley. Arrival in Maasai Mara for lunch and check-in. Afternoon game drive in the reserve. Dinner and overnight at the lodge/camp.

Day 4 – Maasai Mara (Full Day Safari)

Morning and afternoon game drives with picnic lunch, offering excellent opportunities to view the Big Five and other wildlife. Dinner and overnight at the lodge/camp.

Day 5 – Maasai Mara (Full Day Safari)

Another full day of game drives exploring different areas of the reserve. Dinner and overnight at the lodge/camp.

Day 6 – Maasai Mara – Lake Naivasha – Nairobi

Day 7 – Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage & Nairobi Safari Walk

Day 8 – Kazuri Beads Factory & Giraffe Centre

Breakfast and departure from Maasai Mara. Lunch at Lake Naivasha followed by a boat safari to observe hippos and birdlife. Continue to Nairobi in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight in Nairobi.

Morning visit to the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust, followed by the Nairobi Safari Walk. This day focuses on conservation and education. Overnight in Nairobi.

Visit the Kazuri Beads and Pottery Factory, followed by the Giraffe Centre, home to the endangered Rothschild giraffe. Overnight in Nairobi.

Day 9 – Crescent Island Game Sanctuary (Lake Naivasha)

Excursion to Crescent Island for a guided walking safari among giraffes, zebras, wildebeests, and antelopes in a safe and scenic environment. Return to Nairobi for overnight.

Day 10 – Gatura Greens Purple Tea Farm

Full-day excursion to Gatura Greens Tea Farm in Thika, including a guided plantation walk, factory visit, and tea tasting experience featuring Kenya's unique purple tea. Return to Nairobi for a farewell dinner and overnight stay.

Day 11 – Departure

After breakfast, private transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for international departure.

Inclusions:

- ✓ **Accommodation** – at a lodge or tented camp (mid-range)
- ✓ **Meals** – Full-board (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) during the safari.
- ✓ **Transport** – Safari vehicle (either a 4x4 Land Cruiser or a safari van) with a professional driver-guide.
- ✓ **Game Drives** – Multiple game drives in Amboseli to see wildlife, including elephants, lions, cheetahs, and birds.
- ✓ **Park Entrance Fees** - This will be included for the duration of the stay
- ✓ **English-speaking Guide** – A knowledgeable driver-guide for wildlife spotting and park information.
- ✓ **Pick-up and Drop-off** – Transfers from and to Nairobi (hotel or airport).

Exclusions:

- ✗ **Drinks** – Alcoholic and soft drinks at lodges/camps.
- ✗ **Tips and Gratuities** – For guides, drivers, and lodge staff.
- ✗ **Personal Expenses** – Souvenirs, laundry, phone calls, etc.
- ✗ **Travel Insurance** – Not usually included; it's advisable to get one.
- ✗ **Optional Activities** – Such as Maasai village visits, hot air balloon safaris, or nature walks.
